YEAR R HEALTH SCREENING

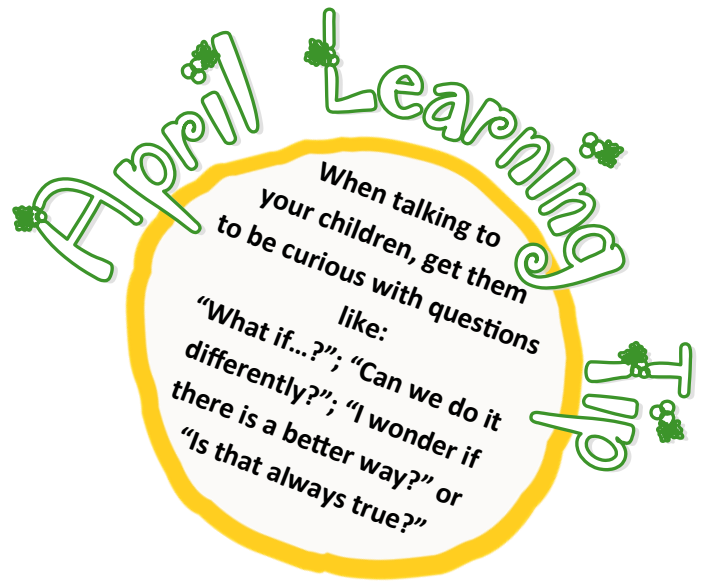
Just to let you know that the Year R screening has now finished. Height, weight, hearing and eyes all checked. The NHS will inform you if any follow up appointment is required.
