INFANT AGILITY CHAMPIONS

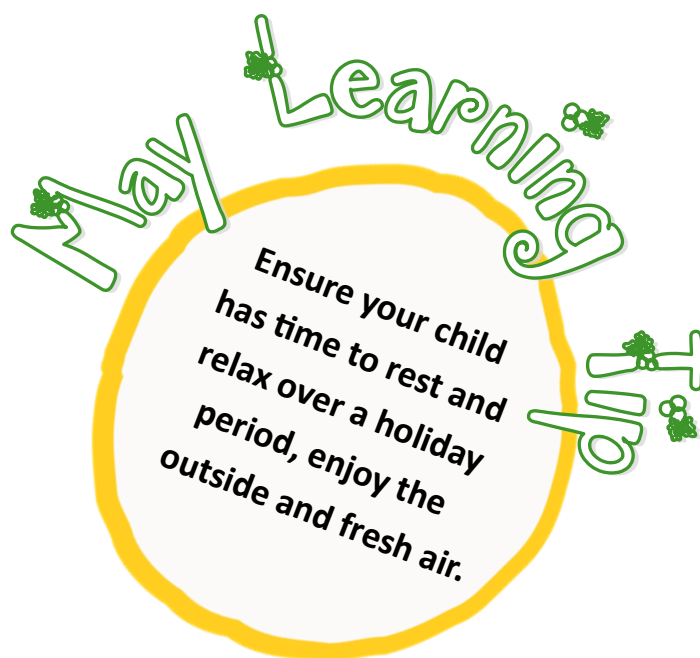
