## SPORTING EVENTS

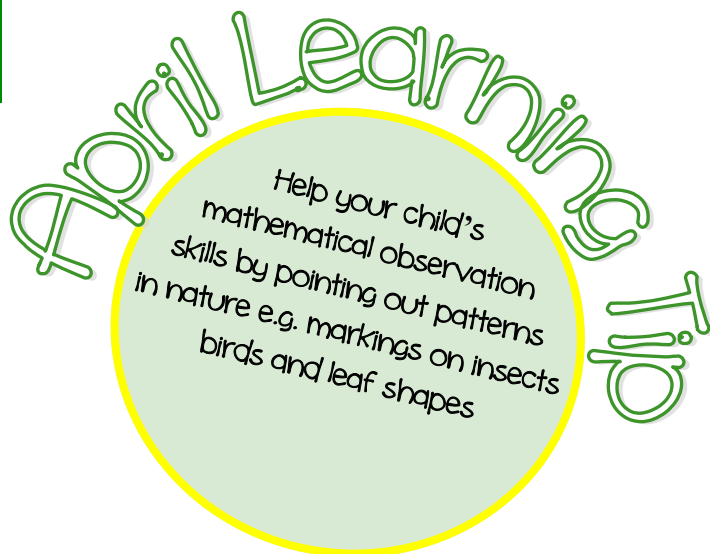
Year 2 pupils represented Callis at the **Thanet Football Festival** on Thursday 25th April. They played five matches and won one match. They all had great fun.
